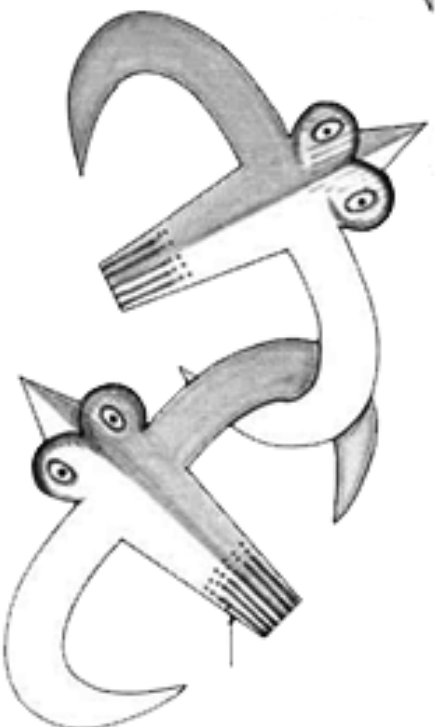


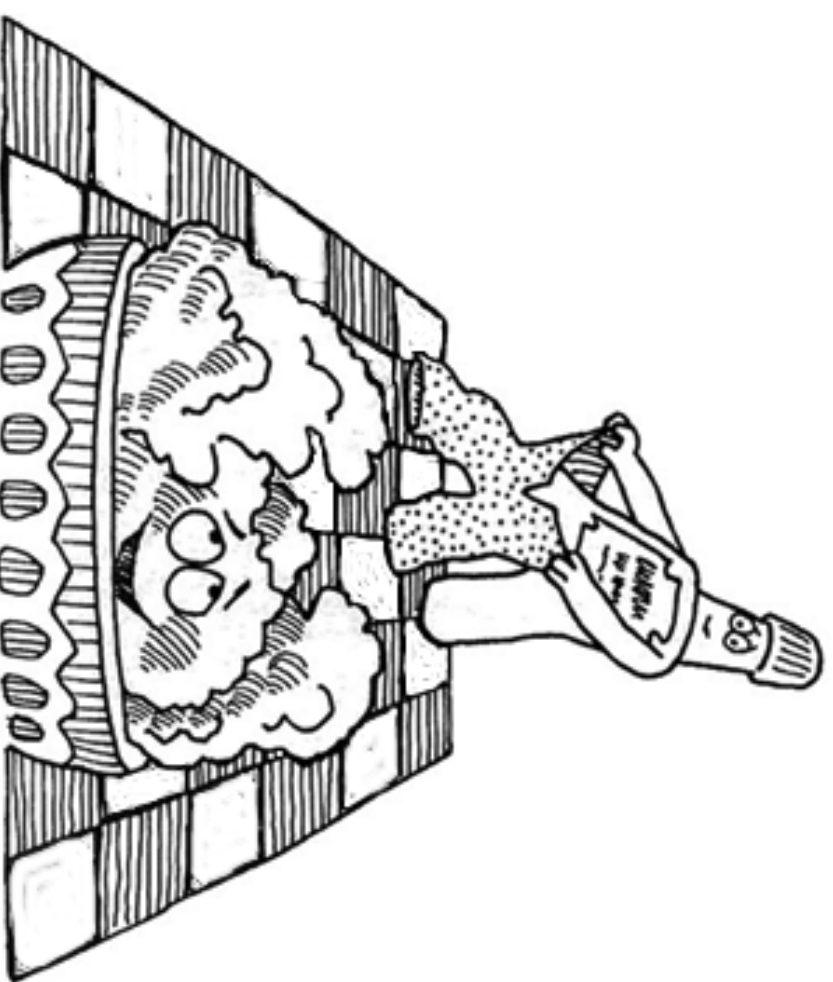
Hook-On Hangers

The finger frog on the previous page has nice curved legs. If you cut shapes with even more curves, you will be able to hook them together, making your very own hook-on pets. You must start by learning to cut a good curve or hook. The shape shown, cut double, will look like a letter C when you open it.



Cut another one exactly the same and see how you can hook them together. It's easy.

Now you can make some hook-on wheeling gulls. Put a thread on the top shape and hang them so they will move gently.

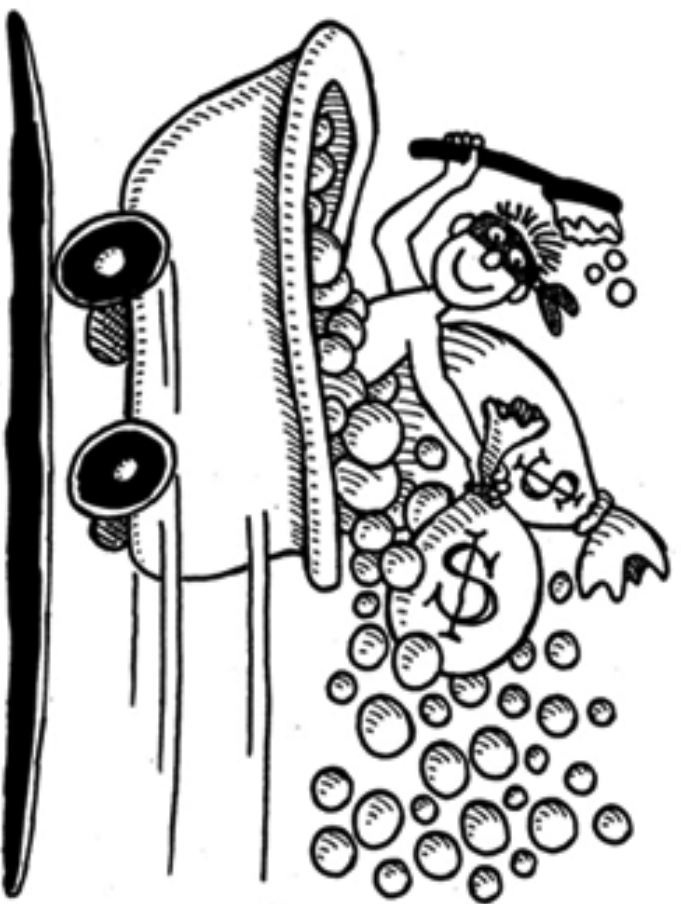


Why was the lettuce embarrassed?
